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**Purpose** The purpose of this letter is to inform staff of the following:

- County Medical Services Program Guide (CMSPG) has been created and is available online under County Medical Services Program Guide (CMSPG).
- Issuance of the Low Income Health Program (LIHP) Program Guide (PG).
- CMSPG will contain Article A as the Low Income Health Program (LIHP) Program Guide (PG).
- Article A located for CMS program material will no longer be updated and has been removed from the Medi-Cal Program Guide (MPG).
- LIHP program material will no longer be updated with a hard copy.

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**Background** CMS  
CMS program regulations were housed in the MPG as Article A. CMS program follows Medi-Cal program rules and Article A referenced the MPG.

CI  
The Coverage Initiative (HCCI) program was San Diego's 2007 1115 Medicaid-waiver program thru 06/30/11. The CI program guide contains regulations and operating procedures needed to properly carry out the responsibility to administer the CI program. With the implementation of the new Medicaid-waiver program, LIHP, new regulations went into effect for LIHP on 07/01/11.

Article A and all references to MPG have been removed to create the

The CMSPG includes Article A which is now the Low Income Health Program (LIHP).

Article A in the MPG will no longer be available.

LIHP PG

Article A of the stand alone CMSPG contains program regulations and operating procedures needed for determining LIHP eligibility. LIHP applications are processed using current LIHP regulations except as noted in the program guide where CMS rules and procedures are followed. The CMS IT system has been updated with the new program cites.

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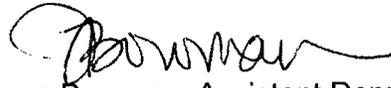
