**Background:**

Senate Bill (SB) 1041 states that a Welfare-to-Work (WTW) mandatory participant who has exhausted their WTW 24-MTC must comply with participation and core hour requirements (CalWORKs Federal Standards).

**Policy:**

Participants who fail without good cause to meet CalWORKs Federal Standards will be removed from the assistance unit (AU); however, the other eligible member of the AU will continue to receive CalWORKs. Removal from cash aid is effective immediately after the 20-Day Cause Determination period if there is no good cause, and noncompliance is not resolved.

There are at least 30 days from the determination of non-compliance to the reduction of the CalWORKs grant. The participant can request to cure his/her removal from cash aid at any time and will be added back to the AU after successfully completing a curing plan.

CalFresh benefits will not be impacted for participants who are removed from cash aid due to Post WTW 24-MTC noncompliance.
