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### 40-200.B.1 Employment Services Discussion

The eligibility worker provides applicants and recipients with information about Welfare-to-Work (WTW), Cal-Learn, and Child Care programs during the face-to-face interview:

- At initial application;
- At annual redetermination; and
- When there is a new household member who is age 16 or older.
