Subject EXTENSION TO THE WELFARE-TO-WORK (WTW) 24-MONTH TIME CLOCK

Effective Date Upon receipt

Reference ACL 14-09: Senate Bill (SB) 1041–Extension to the Welfare-to-Work (WTW) 24-Month Time Clock.

Purpose To inform Eligibility and Employment Services staff that a new section has been added to [CPG](#) to explain the methodology used by the California Department of Social Services (CDSS) for calculating the number of extensions available to each county.

Background Senate Bill (SB) 1041 allows for an extension of the Welfare-to-Work (WTW) 24-Month Time Clock to qualifying participants.

Client Correspondence Pending CDSS issuance of forms and notices related to the WTW 24-Month Time Clock, Employment Case Managers (ECMs) will provide county form 27-378 HHS (E/Sp) to all participants requesting an extension.

Eligibility Operations will develop and provide WTW 24-Month Time Clock Extension approval and denial notices if not made available by CDSS and/or the WCDS Project (CalWIN).

Other Programs Impact No impact.

Child Care Impact Extended childcare supportive services may be approved for qualifying WTW recipients whose WTW 24-Month Time Clock is extended

ACCESS Impact WTW participants seeking information related to the extension of their WRW 24-Month Time Clock will be referred to their Employment Case Manager (ECM).

Document Capture and Forms Impact The ECM is required to process form 27-378 (WtW 24-Month Clock Extension Request) submitted by the participant and file copy in the WTW case file.

Quality Control (QC) Impact QC will cite the appropriate error on any case that does not comply with the requirements outlined in this material.
