

90-400.12. STUDENT INCOME

A. General

This section provides information on the treatment of student income in the GR Program.

B. Policy

All students shall be required to apply for student income through the financial aid office of the school and provide evidence of application for such student income.

Student income shall include awards, grants, scholarships, loans, work study, and any other student income that may be available through the school.

C. Treatment as Income

Student income from any source shall be prorated from the month of receipt through the balance of the school term that such income is intended to cover. Deductions from student income (prior to proration) shall include registration fees, tuition, and books when receipts are presented as verification of such expense. These deductions shall be allowed only when paid from student income after receipt of such income. Expenses which were incurred prior to receipt of student income shall not be allowed.

If as a result of prorating student income the monthly balance exceeds the appropriate GR Basic Need Rate, the case shall be discontinued for excess income and the student shall be ineligible for the balance of the school term.
