

90-700.12. INJURY ON THE WORK SITE AND GOOD CAUSE FOR NONATTENDANCE

A. General This section provides information on the treatment of injuries on the GR WP work site and good cause for nonattendance.

B. Injury on the Work Site If an applicant/recipient is injured at a GR WP site, the Granted Bank Clerk, worker, or WP Site Supervisor shall immediately notify the CalFresh E&T SW. The CalFresh E&T SW shall then take appropriate follow-up action for potential Worker's Compensation and/or medical claims.

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C. Good Cause for Non-attendance In determining if good cause exists for nonattendance at the WP, the CalFresh E&T SW will review the circumstances with the applicant/recipient to determine if there was good cause, negligence, or willfulness involved in the absence. The CalFresh E&T SW should try to establish if the nonattendance was due to circumstances beyond the control of the applicant, or due to negligence.

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D. Good Cause Found When good cause has been found, the case will continue. Verification of good cause shall be documented in the CalFresh E&T case narrative and on Form 11-67 HHSA. Verifications are to be filed in the CalFresh E&T folder.

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E. Good Cause Not Found When good cause for nonattendance is not found, and the nonattendance did not occur due to negligence, the CalFresh E&T SW will then determine willfulness (See [GRPG 90-700.18](#)).

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F. Third Party Contacts Third party contacts must be documented on Form 11-14 HHSA.
