

## 90-700.17. TRANSFERS BETWEEN PROGRAMS

**A.  
General**

This section provides information on the treatment of situations in which the GR recipient loses his/her employable status.

**B.  
Transfers  
between AB,  
UE, IP, or IAP**

Transfers between programs will be based on the definitions for each program as defined in [GRPG 90-700.1](#).

If ...	Then ...
an AB recipient becomes eligible to UE, IP, or IAP during the POE	the TMP will remain the same.
the individual again becomes eligible as an AB during the initial TMP,	the individual will only be eligible for any months that remain of the POE.
the POE has already been met	the person will not be eligible again until a new TMP is established.
the initial TMP is completed before the person is again eligible as an AB applicant/recipient	a new TMP will be established along with a new POE when the person becomes AB eligible again.

**C.  
AB to UE/IP/  
IAP**

If an AB recipient becomes eligible to UE, IP, or IAP at any time during the POE, the months in receipt of appropriate UE, IP, or IAP benefits will be disregarded from consideration as meeting the POE. Appropriate receipt means that all eligibility criteria for the program were met in the month of benefit issuance.

<p>An AB becomes eligible to GR on February 7, 2007. The first month of the POE is March. On March 20, 2007, the person notifies the worker that he/she is eligible for \$50/week SDI. The first payment of \$100 will be received in April 2007. The person remains eligible to GR. IP will begin April 2007 and a recertification date of 7/2007 will be entered.</p>	<p>Ends March 31, 2007.</p>	<p>Begins April 1, 2007.</p>	<p>March 2007 through February 2008.</p>	<p>Beings March 2007 for a three-month period. The person will have two more months of AB eligibility in TMP if IP eligibility ends and AB eligibility is redetermined.</p>
<p>An AB becomes eligible to GR on March 1, 2007. The first month of the POE is March. On May 15, 2007, the person is granted VA disability of \$99/month and will receive the first check in June. The person remains eligible to GR.</p>	<p>Ends May 31, 2007.</p>	<p>Begins June 1, 2007.</p>	<p>March 2007 through February 2008.</p>	<p>March 2007 through May 2007. No further AB eligibility until March 2008.</p>
<p>An AB becomes eligible to GR on April 1, 2007. The first month of the POE is April. On June 10, 2007, the person is determined to be disabled through a medical evaluation. The person is a legal alien who has been in the country for five years and has worked for two years. The person applied for SDI and expects \$50/week with the first check to be received in July. The person has also applied for SSI but has been denied due to alien status.</p>	<p>Ends June 30, 2007.</p>	<p>Begins July 1, 2007.</p>	<p>April 2007 through March 2008.</p>	<p>April 2007 through June 2007. No further AB eligibility until April 2008.</p>

**D. UE/IP/IAP to AB** The table below shows some examples of cases where an UE/IP/IAP recipient becomes eligible for AB assistance.

Situation	UE/IP/IAP	AB	TMP	POE
On March 5, 2007, an IAP person is denied SSI, has completed reconsideration, and has no new evidence of disability which might qualify for SSI. The person remains otherwise eligible for GR and is classified as AB. The person has not received AB assistance after January 1, 2007.	Ends March 31, 1997.	Begins April 1, 2007.	April 2007 through March 2008.	Begins April 2007 for a three-month period.
On October 28, 2007, an IP person notifies the worker that the last SDI check will be received November 7, 2007. The person is determined to be AB on November 10, 2007. The person had received AB assistance from January 12, 2007 through February 2007.	Ends November 30, 2007.	Begins December 1, 2007.	February 2007 through January 2008.	February 2007, December 2007, and January 2008.
			February 2008 through January 2009.	February 2008 for a three-month period.

The sanction will be applied when the period of unemployability expires before the sanction period does.
