

90-750.1. INCAPACITATED PROGRAM (IP) POLICY

A. General This section provides general information on the GR Incapacitated Program (IP).

B. Definition IP applicants/recipients are those who are temporarily unable to work. They are in receipt of income, which is based on the disability. Types of income usually received include, but are not limited to, SDI, VA payments for 100% disability, SSA disability payments, RR payments based on disability, Worker's Compensation payments, and private disability insurance payments.

Note: Persons who are unable to work due to an illness or injury but are not receiving disability-based income must qualify for GR under the EL category.

C. Purpose The purpose of the GR IP is to provide emergency financial assistance to eligible applicants/recipients who are unable to work or engage in employment activities and who are receiving disability-based income.

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D. Objectives The IP is directed at those persons who are temporarily unable to work or who have an illness or injury that prevents them from working or working in their usual occupation. This is accomplished by:

- requiring proof of disability-based income, such as SDI or Worker's Compensation
- encouraging participation in training or rehabilitation programs in an effort to get the individual back into the labor market
- referring potential eligible applicants/recipients to other income resources such as SSA disability, SSI, VA disability, Vocational Rehabilitation, etc.
