

90-900 APPENDIX A. HEARING RIGHTS

WHAT YOU CAN DO

Call your worker within five days of this notice to give your reason why you disagree. You may also ask a supervisor to review your case. Or you can ask for a hearing by following the instructions below.

HOW TO ASK FOR A HEARING

The last day you may request a hearing is ten (10) days after the effective date of the action. Your worker can help you ask for a hearing.

To ask for a hearing, write or call the "GR Calendar Clerk" at:

If you want us to keep paying your GR until the hearing, you must ask your worker to Aid Paid Pending before the effective date of action.

If you ask for a hearing, you have the right to look at your file, look at the rules the County used in your case, bring witnesses, tell your side of the case, cross-examine the County's witnesses, and have someone represent you at the hearing. For free legal assistance, you can call the Legal Aid Society at (877) 534-2524.

Your hearing will be held at 1255 Imperial Avenue, Suite 300, San Diego, CA 92101.

YOU MUST BE ON TIME for the hearing. If you are more than 15 minutes late, you may lose your case. If you cannot attend your hearing, you must call the GR Calendar Clerk to postpone your hearing.
