Subject	COUNTY MEDICAL SERVICES (CMS) INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (IT) SYSTEM
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Effective Date	May 12, 2008
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Reference	County Policy
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Purpose	The purpose of this letter is to inform GR staff of the new CMS IT System requirements.
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Background	Currently, GR workers must complete a CMS-4 to enroll GR applicants/recipients into the CMS system.
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Changes	Effective May 12, 2008, GR workers will no longer complete the CMS-4. This form is replaced by the GR Apps screen in the CMS IT System.
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Required Action	As of May 12, 2008, GR workers will enter the appropriate information as identified in the Automation Impact section, below, to enroll the GR applicant/recipient into the CMS Program.
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CMS Cards	The CMS IT System will not generate the CMS Notice of Action (NOA) or CMS Card for GR recipients. The CMS Card will still be issued by the GR worker as currently stated in the GRPG.
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Automation Impact	<p>The CMS IT System is a web based system and may be accessed via any PC with internet access. 2	Go to URL https://www.sdcmsapps.com/cgi-bin/login/pl .
3	Enter User Name and Password.
4	Press "Login."
5	Change Password (on first log in only). The "Welcome Page" will show.
6	Select "GR Apps."
7	Complete the GR application page with appropriate applicant information.
8	Select "Submit."

Forms Impact The CMS-4 is obsolete as of May 12, 2008.
