Purpose The purpose of this letter is to inform staff that the GRPG:

- Has been re-written into a new format;
- Is now available on the internet; and
- Will no longer be updated with a hard copy.

Background The County of San Diego is moving towards using automated technology instead of paper to produce Program Guides. As a result, the Program Guides will now be accessible online.

Changes The GRPG has been re-written into a new format called “Infomapping.” This format is intended to be easier to understand and to be read in an electronic format.

Effective October 1, 2008, the GRPG will be up to date and entirely online. It can be reached by going to <http://hhsa-pg.sdcounty.ca.gov>. Then click on “General Relief Program Guide.”

Future Updates All future updates to the GRPG will be released electronically. A copy of the letter or Special Notice (SN) will be sent via e-mail. The GRPG will be updated online effective 7 calendar days from the e-mail. No further paper copies will be issued.
