


# Processing Guide – Targeted Low Income Children’s Program



**Purpose** To provide TLICP evaluation instructions for Single Point Entry (SPE) and non-SPE cases including applications, redeterminations and changes in circumstance. EDBC logic for the TLICP aid codes will not be programmed until mid March 2013.

**TLICP Evaluations** Until the logic is in CalWIN, workers must take the following steps when handling children’s applications:

Step	Action	
1	Complete case evaluation in CalWIN	
	<b>If child is determined eligible to...</b>	<b>Then ...</b>
	zero SOC Medi-Cal	grant case
	Medi-Cal with a SOC	go to Step 2
2	Complete manual budgets available at S:\ENTERPRISE\QR Excel Spreadsheet\Budget Worksheets 040112 thru 033113	
	<b>If child is determined...</b>	<b>Then ...</b>
	ineligible to TLICP	go to Step 3
	eligible to TLICP	go to Step 4
3	Clear application on MEDS	
	<b>If the child...</b>	<b>Then ...</b>
	shows an AIM “OC” aid code in the last 12 months	refer to HFP as outlined in <a href="#">MPG 05.08.05</a> and go to Step 5
	meets CEC criteria	grant CEC and go to Step 5
does not meet CEC criteria	grant appropriate SOC Medi-Cal aid code	
4	Run EDBC	
5	Override Aid Code ( <a href="#">BENDS CR6086-Transition Healthy Families to Medi-Cal</a> )	
6	Capture image manual budgets	
7	Document all actions in Case Comments
