**Purpose:**

To inform staff with policies and procedures for the new Trafficking and Crime Victims Assistance Program (TCVAP)

**Background:**

Senate Bill (SB) 1569, effective January 2007, ensures that specific non-citizen victims of human trafficking, domestic violence or other serious crimes who meet Medi-Cal or Refugee Medical Assistance (RMA) eligibility requirements but do not have Satisfactory Immigration Status (SIS) can receive state-funded full scope Medi-Cal.

**Policy Change:**

TCVAP provides full scope Medi-Cal to trafficking and domestic violence victims who do not currently meet SIS.

**Summary of Changes:**

Added MPG section 05.08.10 – Trafficking and Crime Victims Assistance Program (TCVAP)

**Impacts:**

No impact to other programs.

**Automation:**

Requires aid type override in CalWIN

**Forms and Document Capture:**

No impact to forms and document capture.
