#### **Purpose**

To provide staff with:

- Clarification regarding an Authorized Representative (AR):
  - accompanying, assisting or acting on behalf of a CMS applicant at a CMS County Administrative Hearing; and
- Update of Article A County Medical Services Table of Contents.

#### **Background**

CMS applicants who apply for and are denied CMS benefits have the right to request a County Administrative Hearing. The applicant may designate an AR to accompany, assist, or act on their behalf at the hearing. CMS generally follows Medi-Cal rules regarding Authorized Representatives (AR). The definition and treatment of an AR for CMS and Medi-Cal are the same. An AR may be an individual or an organization.

#### Change

Clarification regarding an AR requesting a CMS Administrative Hearing has been added to Article A.

Authorized Representative form DPA 19/DPA 19 (SP) (Attachment A & Attachment B) or a written statement must be signed and dated by the CMS applicant on or after the date of the action or inaction with which the applicant is dissatisfied when an authorized representative is to act on behalf of the applicant at a CMS County Administrative Hearing.

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# Change (continued)

AR form DPA19 will only be recognized through the hearing/appeal process.

Section 12, Items 2 & 4 (First Level Supervisory Review and Monitoring Compliance), Section 13 (CMS Hardship), and Section 14 (CMS Mail-in Recertification) have been added to Article A County Medical Services Table of Contents.

Article A, Section 12, Table of Contents, has been updated to include sub-items.
