Subject CONFIDENTIALITY POLICIES GOVERNING MEDI-CAL AND THE
MEDI-CAL ELIGIBILITY DATA SYSTEM (MEDS)

Effective Upon receipt.

Reference ACWDL 08-04

Purpose To provide instructions regarding MEDS printouts.

Background Federal Medicaid law requires that medical information on applicants/beneficiaries must be kept confidential and that State Medicaid agencies must provide safeguards that restrict the use or disclosure of information concerning applicants/beneficiaries to purposes directly connected with the administration of the State Medicaid (Medi-Cal in California) program.

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) policy allows certain providers to contact the County for information necessary to verify Medi-Cal program eligibility. However, these organizations must make a good faith effort to obtain the beneficiary's BIC information from the Medi-Cal beneficiary.

Highlighted Clarification This information was not previously included in the MPG to provide a single resource for confidentiality rules. DHCS' policy regarding confidentiality extends to MEDS the MEDS screens including MOPI screens and screen prints. Staff should not allow anyone who does not have a MEDS ID to view MEDS. The MEDS screen prints shall never leave the FRC.

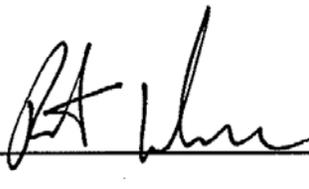
