April 3, 2014

Subject **2014 FEDERAL POVERTY LEVELS (FPL) AND MPG UPDATES WITH SSA COST OF LIVING ADJUSTMENT (COLA) CHANGES**

Effective January 1, 2014

Reference ACWDLs 13-25, 13-26, 14-04,14-07 and 14-13
MPG Special Notice 13-10

Purpose The purpose of this letter is to update the MPG with the changes from the January 1, 2014 SSA COLA and notify staff of the following:

- The increases to the FPLs and the Sneed V. Kizer prorated FPLs for Section 1931(b)
 - The increased property limits for the Medicare Savings Plans (MSP).
 - The FPL COLA Mass Update run has been postponed indefinitely due to the redetermination grandfather period required by ACA changes.
 - The addition of new MAGI related FPL limits to Article 11, Appendix A.
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Background Certain income limits, disregard amounts, and allocation amounts change each year effective on January 1.

The January SSA COLA is disregarded for FPL programs until the new FPLs become effective on April 1st. The FPL based programs include:

- 100% FPL for children ages 6 to 19
- 133% FPL for children ages 1 to 5
- 200% FPL for children under 1 and pregnant women
- TLICP
- Aged and Disabled (A&D) FPL and the Federal Poverty Level Program for the Blind (FPLB)
- Medicare Savings Programs (MSP) (ie, Qualified Medicare

Beneficiary (QMB), Specified Low Income Beneficiary)SLMB, and the Qualified Individual 1 (QI-1).

- Section 1931(b) Applicant or Recipient Budget Method B
- The 250% Working Disabled Program

The Sneeve V. Kiser prorated FPLs for 1931(b) are derived from the annual FPL figures.

Highlighted Changes

Effective 1/1/14

- Property limits for MSPs increased to \$7,160 for an individual and \$10,750 for a couple
- The FPLs for MSPs (QMB, SLMB, or QI-1) **without** SSA Title II income increased.
- The following changes were included in the Social Security COLA that was run December 7, 2013 and have been updated in the MPG:
 - Community Spouse Resource Allowance
 - Community Spouse Income Allocation
 - The Federal Benefit Rate
 - PMV and VTR
 - Pickle disregard computation chart for 2014
 - In-Kind Support and Maintenance (ISM) values
 - Substantial Gainful Activity Amount
 - The Standard Allocation for 250% Working Disabled Program and Medicare Savings Programs

Effective 3/1/14

The FPLs for MSP (QMB, SLMB and QI-1) applicants and recipients **with** SSA Title II income increased.

Effective 4/1/14

FPLs, Blind Federal Poverty Level (FPL-B) income standards, and Sneed v. Kizer prorated FPLs for Section 1931(b) increased.

COLA Mass Update

- DHCS required counties to postpone the usual COLA Mass Update indefinitely in order to comply with the Affordable Care Act (ACA) grandfather period regulations that require counties to take no

negative actions on existing Medi-Cal beneficiaries between 1/1/14 and 5/31/14.

- The FPLs will be updated on the reference tables 3/22/14, so they will be in effect whenever a worker runs EDBC or completes a new application, but the CalWIN Project will not run a mass update and authorization of the Medi-Cal caseload.
- In order to ensure that no cases receive a negative action due to the FPL increase and the SSA COLA increase to RSDI income that was previously disregarded, CalWIN will add a batch exception AU indicator to all cases with RSDI income 3/22/14.
- Cases with the batch exception AU indicator will exception out of batch authorization.
- A daily list of cases that exception out of authorization will be provided on the [Sharepoint Website](#).

**Required
Actions**

Workers must:

- Use the limits, deductions, allocations identified in this letter when determining eligibility and/or share of cost for the appropriate programs.
- Process exception case lists.
- Re-Evaluate MSP cases denied/discontinued as over property between 1/1/14 and 3/22/14.
- Re-Evaluate MSP cases denied/discontinued as over income between 1/1/14 and 3/22/14.

The property limit increase effective 1/1/14 for MSP cases will not be implemented in CalWIN until 3/22/14. A list of MSP cases denied or discontinued between 1/1/14 and 3/22/14 as over property will be posted on [Sharepoint](#). These cases must be reviewed to determine if the property is below the new limit and eligibility re-established if otherwise eligible.

For MSP cases denied/discontinued as over property between 1/1/14 and 3/22/14, workers must:

Step	Action
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1	Review the case to determine if eligibility exists for January 1 st and ongoing
2	Re-Run EDBC and indicate Y on the Capture Discrepancy window for January through March 2014.
3	Narrate case actions and send appropriate NOAs.

Instructions for Current Year Title II Disregard Computation Chart

This chart replaces and supersedes all previous Title II Disregard Computation charts. The steps to be taken to use this chart are outlined below.

1. Determine the current benefit amount.
 2. Determine when the last SSI/SSP check was received.
 3. Multiply the current benefit amount by the multiplier for the time period the last SSI/SSP check was received.
 4. The result is the amount to be disregarded.
